Adult Chinook retention closes effective Sep. 10 downstream of the Warrior Rock line, the area remains open to adipose fin-clipped coho and adipose fin-clipped steelhead. In the area upstream of the Warrior Rock line, Chinook retention remains open, and the daily bag limit increases to two adult Chinook effective Sep. 10*
